Satpura Transco Private Limited, Madhya Pradesh: 1050 MW | Acquired in November 2019

Satpura Transco Private Limited (STPL) is in the Sarni district in Madhya Pradesh. The STPL transmission asset is a 240 km long, 400kV double circuit with twin moose ACSR conductor transmission line passing through agricultural land, forest area, hilly terrain, and crossing Narmada, which is a major river in the central part of India.

The transmission line is designed to evacuate 1050 MW of Power from the Satpura Thermal Power Plant under the aegis of MPPTCL and is commissioned in 2015 under DBFOT Program (Design, Build, Finance, Operate, and Transfer).
